The Llambias House Garden



Attached to the Fernández-Llambias House,
long associated with St. Augustine's
distinctive Minorcan community.

The house is also a National Historic Landmark.
Noted for its luxuriant arbor and large coquina well,
shaded by magnificent oaks and cedars.
